a vibrant, healthy community for all ages


The 2021 census reports a 27% increase in full-time residents since 2016. This is a major shift. Seniors continue to be our largest growth "industry". The over 55 age group now represents 64% of our neighbours. Creating jobs to attract & retain young families in McKellar is key to future sustainability.

rural sustainability strategy

Agri-tourism, like the "farm to fork" phenomenon provides more options for local job creation and to shop local while respecting the heritage and environment of a rural community. The success of our McKellar Market is one such example.

aging in place

As we "age in place" we must find ways to provide better support for in-home services, including having safe accessible roads year round.



courage to collaborate



progressive financial management

Forward-thinking financial options, like debentures, are necessary in today's uncertain market. We can leverage a low-interest loan for fixed assets that is essential for prudent "pay forward" financial management and to stabilize annual budget increases. "Cash only" policies and the "hoarding" of capital reserves actually cost the taxpayer more in the long term.
